

As a busy regional airport handling so many passengers it requires effective communication for general announcements and any potential emergency situations. The airport's fire alarm system is connected to a Bosch PAVA system which broadcasts evacuation messages through the loudspeaker network in the event of an emergency.



As Bosch approved PAVA specialists, PAS were brought in during 2015 to take over the routine maintenance of the system and carry out a thorough survey and report on its status. As a result of this, a number of remedial and improvement works were proposed to align the system with the latest requirements of the British Standards.
