



The £5.2 million Toxteth Fire Fit Hub combines a traditional fire station with a youth centre open to the public.

The Hub, which was built by Wates Construction and is based in the heart of Liverpool, is a unique project which sees a youth centre with sporting facilities as part of the Myplace scheme providing world class facilities for young people and a community fire station on the same site. These include a sports hall, martial arts and dance studio and four five-a-side football pitches.

PAS Sound supplied the public address systems to both the leisure centre and the fire station as part of our contract with A&B Engineering Ltd who were the M&E contractor on the site. Having supplied public address systems to Merseyside Fire and Rescue Service for over twenty five years, PAS had a full understanding of the unique requirements of the combined public address and call out system.
